A Monochromatic Affair

5. Creative wedding favour ideas include woven coasters from ANTHROPOLOGY, tile magnets and badges from AMEBA, and playing cards sweets from CORDUROY CANDY. 6. Serve a cup of nice, hot white tea to your guests in pretty cups from LIM'S ARTS AND LIVING. Write little notes to thank your guests personally with cards from PRINTS and give them little 'Groom' keyholders from AMEBA as parting gifts. 7. Set against a plain black background, unusual table arrangements like this one from SING SEE SOON make a good conversational piece.





1. Go simple with your choice of boutonnieres for your men. A white orchid from SING SEE SOON does the trick. If you are using plain tableware, decorate patterned table tops using PAPERCHASE wrappers. 2. Attach liquorice swirl sticks from CORDUROY CANDY onto your wedding invitation cards to entice your guests. A single stalk of Calla Lily placed against a black table brings out its beauty. 3. Print your lunch menu or programme using stationery from PROMISES WEDDINGS and place them beside tin candles from PAPERCHASE to enhance the ambience. 4. To protect the table from crumbs, place woven placemats from ANTHROPOLOGY on the tables. Leave bookmarks with interesting designs from CARDBLANCHE for your guests to take home.
